Subject: Virgin Islands CE

Effective January 1, 2024, the United States Virgin Islands (USVI) Division of Banking, Insurance and Financial Regulation will begin requiring resident insurance licensees to complete 12 (9 General and 3 Ethics) Continuing Education (CE) credits prior to submitting their renewal application for calendar year 2025.

These new CE requirements apply to USVI resident licensees that hold either a valid Insurance Producer, Public Adjuster, Independent Adjuster and/or Solicitor license.

Additional information with instructions on finding approved CE courses and tracking your progress using your USVI Continuing Education Transcript will be made available, on or before, January 15, 2024
